<b>A1</b> ELEMENTARY	You understand short phrases if known or repeated. You can express your basic needs. You can identify and reproduce single words or memorised expressions.
<b>A2</b> UPPER ELEMENTARY	You can understand practical information in simple messages of everyday life. You can make yourself understood in familiar and expected situations.
<b>B1</b> INTERMEDIATE	You understand the important information in texts and oral output about known or expected situations. You express yourself with ease on subjects dealing with everyday life.
<b>B2</b> UPPER INTERMEDIATE	You understand detailed information in texts or oral output dealing with a familiar, concrete or abstract topic. You express yourself clearly about subjects that you are interested in.
C1 ADVANCED	You understand the specifics of complex texts and oral outputs on subjects relating to social and professional life. You express yourself with confidence and precision when discussing a range of topics.
C2 VERY ADVANCED	You understand everything you read or hear in a range of subjects. You understand the subtleties of the language and easily interpret complex documents. You express yourself correctly and fluently without hesitation. You can debate complex subjects.
